Local Rules

1 Out of Bounds (Rule 18):

- (a) Beyond the inside point, at ground level, of any fence or hedge bounding the course.
- (b) Beyond the inside points, at ground level, of the white stakes bounding the club house, practice putting green, car park and road.
- (c) Internal “out of bounds” - beyond the inside points of the white stakes to the left-hand side of the 2nd hole and the left-hand and right-hand sides of the 4th hole.

- 2 Tractor ruts and sheep tracks to fairways and rough to be treated as “Abnormal Ground Conditions” (Rule 16.1 applies). Tractor rut only applies to deep ruts only.
- 3 Greenside electric fences and fence posts are immovable objects (rule 16.1 applies).
- 4 A ball striking a greenside fence, fence or marker post of the hole being played may be replayed if contact is made on the approach to the green. Ball being dropped at its original position not nearer the hole (rule 14,6 applies).
- 5 Piles of grass cuttings are “Ground Under Repair”, (relief to be taken as directed under rule 16.1).
- 6 When playing the 9th/18th holes, a ball coming to rest on the 8th/17th green must be played, without penalty, from the drop zone provided behind the green (rule 13.1 f applies).
