KNIGHTON GOLF CLUB - LOCAL RULES – APRIL 2026

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 18.2)

- a) Beyond the **course side edge** of any fence, hedge, white line or line of white stakes defining the boundary of the course, the clubhouse, practice putting green, car park and road.
- b) Beyond the inside points of the white stakes to the left-hand side of the 2nd hole and beyond the inside points of the white stakes to the left-hand and right-hand sides of the 4th hole.

2. ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS (Rule 16)

2.1 Ground Under Repair

- a) **Free relief** under Rule 16.1 is available for **deep** tractor ruts and sheep tracks **in the general area**.
- b) Grass cuttings piled for removal are to be treated as Ground Under Repair. **Free relief** is available under Rule 16.1.
- c) At the player's option, in the general area, dung from sheep may be treated as:
 - i. A loose impediment that may be removed under Rule 15.1; or
 - ii. Ground under repair, from which **Free relief** is allowed for interference to the **lie of the ball only** under Rule 16.1. No relief is allowed for interference to the player's stance or area of intended swing.

2.2 Immovable Obstructions

- a) A ball which strikes a greenside fence or marker post following an approach shot to the green of the hole being played may be replayed. **Free relief** is available under Rule 14.6b.
Free relief is available under Rule 16.1 for the following:
 - a) Interference from greenside electric fences and fence posts. If playing the ball as it lies, the electricity supply to the fence may be turned off but must be switched on after the ball has been played;
 - b) Interference from Aqua Duct inspection pipes;
 - c) Course furniture;
 - d) Wooden edging boards.

3. WRONG GREEN (Rule 13.1f)

Free relief under Rule 13.1f must be taken for a ball which comes to rest on the 8th/17th green during play of the 9th/18th holes. The nearest point of complete relief must be outside of the electric fence.

4. INTEGRAL OBJECTS (Rule 8.1a)

Offa's Dyke Path is an integral object from which free relief is not allowed.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE: General Penalty (loss of hole in match play or two penalty strokes in stroke play).
